Re: Goose Creek Area, Northeastern Nevada

Dear Mr. Luke:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation of July 23, 1992, I researched the records of this office to determine what if any permits have been issued on Goose Creek or tributaries since the state decree.

I personally researched the records and found that no additional permits have been issued on any stream source within the Nevada portion of the Goose Creek hydrographic basin since the Nevada State decree was issued in March 1923.

The only permit, relevant to our discussion, was a change in the place of use and various points of diversion of Goose Creek waters granted by the Nevada State Engineer in 1964. This permit, 21763, does not constitute an additional appropriation only a change from the original decree.

Various stockwatering rights exist in the area but the sources are small springs not tributary to the decreed system and underground sources. No irrigation rights exist in the Nevada portion of the Goose Creek drainage except those recognized in the decree.
