Dear Sir:

Representatives of the State Engineer's office made a field review of the Willow Spring area with Mr. Mike Shannon. During the field review on August 18, 1992, it was noted that the diversion works supplying 13-483 and 484 were in a depression north of the main spring area. The State Engineer's office believes that the relationship between the main spring and the water developed by the later priority users may not be direct enough to see an affect in the south portion of the spring if the outlet for the subsequent priorities was plugged. The State Engineer does recognize that the 1869 priority water under 13-2215 has the first right to be filled.

Further investigations of flows will need to be made before the State Engineer will jeopardize the water flows from diversion works that currently exist.
