The Annual Meeting of the Burntfork-Birch Creek Water Users was held at the Mc Kinnon Schoolhouse on March, 15, 1965.

Donald Norseth called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and gave a recap of the meeting held in 1964. Mr. Norseth then read the Water Commissioner's report for the year 1964.

The Financial Report for 1964 was read by Mr. Frank Reese with Bob Gamble making the motion that the Financial Report be accepted as read. Ray Sadlier seconded the motion, and the motion carried. The discussion was then brought up as to what the assessment would be for 1965. Ray Sadlier made the motion that the assessment be left at the set up amount. Bob Gamble seconded the motion and motion carried.

Those present at the meeting were Frank Reese, Donald C. Norseth, Bob Gamble, Laray Sadlier, Albert Wilde, Alonzo R. Jarvie, Milton Beck, Orson Behunin, John a Teichert, and Willard J. Stringer.

The finances for the Water Commissioner were discussed with John Teichert on Wyoming's share and he stated he was trying to have it set up to where Sweetwater County would pay \$360.00 and the State of Wyoming \$200.00 for the total of \$560.00, set up for Wyoming's share.

It was voted on and approved by all present that the Water Committee stay the same for 1965, with the exception of Ronald Smith, for whom Orson Behunin nominated Earl Hanks in his place and Alonzo Jarvie seconded the motion and motion carried.

Mr. Lyle Anderson sent in his letter of resignation asking to be replaced as Water Commissioner, and upon his resignation, the Committee was given until April 15, 1965 to find a new Water Commissioner. The Committee then met April 2, 1965, at the home of Jim Scott to see if he would accept the job. Jim Scott accepted the Water Commissioner's job, at which time the State of Utah and Willard Stringer were notified immediately.
