Willard Stringer - Commissioners report

- A. Recommendations
  1. Measuring devices
- B. Water supply was adequate
- C. Made 13 trips into the area but no record of flows was kept due to the lack of measuring devices.
- D. Willard asked several questions:
  1. What right of trespass he had to regulate water:  
Ans. Norseth answered the Commissioner has the right to trespass but not to damage.
  2. If individuals who own a ditch has to maintain it?  
Ans. Individual must operate and maintain ditch in a safe manner.

Discussion on difference between Utah and Wyoming water laws.

1. Don explained (a) acrefeet limitation (2) priority (3) flow (4) period of use (5) Don also mentioned that Wyoming and Utah are working on an interstate schedule that will equalize water allotment between the users of each state.

1968 Budget
