Re: Burnt Fork/Birch Creek
Beaver Creek Dist. Sys.

In accordance with Section 73-5-1 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as Amended, the State Engineer appoints river commissioners for a one year term beginning April 1 and ending March 31 of the following year.

In accordance with Section 73-5-3 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as Amended, the river commissioner has authority to regulate the diversions on the stream to insure the flow is distributed according to the water right. This authority extends throughout the appointed term of the commissioner. Therefore, you are to regulate water during your term whenever necessary whether during the irrigation season or not.
