Mr. Eyre:

This notice is to confirm our telephone conversation of January 5, 1988 regarding your delinquent assessment for Account # 1, Lyman Grazing on the Beaver Creek Distribution System.

As we discussed, the account is delinquent in the amount of \$554.40 which includes a 10 % delinquent assessment. This is the 1987 assessed amount for your account which represents irrigated acreage in Utah only. The system account is currently in a deficit situation and the bill must be paid immediately in order to avoid further action by the attorney general and state engineers offices.

If the bill remains unpaid, a lien may be placed against the property being irrigated and the commissioner may be ordered to cease delivery of water to the property by tagging and locking the diversion.

Please remit the entire amount of \$554.40 to the state engineer at your earliest convenience to avoid possible loss of the use of your water right for the upcoming irrigation season.
