Dear Sir:

In keeping with the promise Mr. Jerman made to you while in Burnt Fork June 12, I am enclosing herewith, tabulations showing the water rights on Beaver Creek and Burnt Fork, Summit County. You will note on each of these tabulations under No. 1, the rights are those initiated prior to 1905, this being the date of the establishing of the State Engineer's Office. This information is only tentative and subject to change as more facts are gathered.

I would suggest you keep a note of any changes you find necessary and at the end of the irrigation season, furnish this office with the information gathered in order that we may have our records as nearly correct as possible.

This being the best information available at this time, it is the information you will have to use until such time as these rights will have been adjudicated by the court. The rights set forth under No. 2, are the rights of record in the State Engineer's Office.
