RE: BURNT FORK DIST.

I am in receipt of a letter from Mr. George H. Crosby, Jr., representing Mr. Reed Hanks, requesting me to appoint you my field representative, with the limited function of measuring the draft of water from a reservoir owned by Mr. Hanks on Beaver Creek in Utah, and allowing the diversion lower down on Beaver Creek for the benefit of Mr. Hanks of the water so drawn from the reservoir with proper allowance for seepage and evaporation.

I am herewith giving you such authority as my field representative with the understanding that your compensation for performing such service is to be without charge to the State of Utah and taken care of by Mr. Hanks.
