August 27, 1943.

The meeting was called to order by David Miller, Supt. of Water Division No. 4, and, thereafter, it was moved and seconded that Louis Stall be appointed Secretary of the meeting. Mr. Miller made an opening statement as to the purpose of the meeting, stating that negotiations were being initiated toward the formation of a compact between the states of Wyoming and Utah covering the distribution of the water of Henrys Fork, Beaver Creek and Birch Creek. Mr. Monson, Assistant State Engineer of the State of Utah, was introduced. Thereafter an inspection of the Burnt Fork area was made by Mr. Monson, Mr. Miller and Mr. Stall, noting the points of diversions of the principal ditches.
