Dear Mr. Miller:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of August 9, 1943, in which you recommend appointment of Alden White and Austin Stevens of McKinnon as Assistant Compact Commissioners to assist the Interstate Streams Commissioner in negotiating a compact for division of the waters of Burnt Fork Creek, Beaver Creek, and Henry's Fork Creek.

I am this date recommending to Governor Hunt appointment of these appropriators and yourself to act as assistant commissioners.

I agree with you that Beaver Creek and Henry's Fork Creek can well be included in the negotiations, and at an early date will ask the Governor to make a request of Congress for authorization for a compact covering these tributaries which originate in the State of Utah.
