Dear Sir:

I am writing in regards to your letter of June 4. The ditch my father helped to build is the Edwards canal. I believe the information you have about him working for some one else was when he worked on a ditch for Mr. Gamble I have been watering this place since 1928 and before that Mr. Frank O. Mahoney irrigated it. Mr. Mahoney irrigated the place after the death of my father.

I met Mr. Bullock a couple of weeks ago and told him about the water and he turned the water out for this place. When we met with Mr. Bullock we explained as near as we could about the water for all the ditches out of Burnt fork in Utah.

I believe that most of the trouble over this water is started by Wyoming people. There is plenty of water for the Utah rights. The land would be worthless without the water.

The water that I use comes out of the same canal as C. E. Galbreaths the places join.

If there is any one that claims that the water has not been used on this place I would like to know who they are.
