To: All Water Users

Wyoming and Utah representatives are proposing a meeting with the Birch Creek and Burnt Fork water users, Monday, March 17, 1958, at 1:00 P.M. in the Manila Courthouse.

It is hoped at this meeting a distribution program may be adopted that it may be put in practice during the 1958 irrigation season.

The adoption of a distribution program will require agreement with the users on the following items of business:

1. To select a competent water commissioner.
2. To adopt a budget to cover distribution cost for 1958.
3. To determine a basis for assessment and a mode of collection.

It is suggested all Birch Creek and Burnt Fork users attend that their interest will be properly represented.
