I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letters of May 6, 1957 and May 8, 1957 in which you advise that Clifton Johnson of your office will be in the Burnt Fork area on May 16 to go over the entire Burnt Fork distribution system for the summer of 1957 conjointly with the Wyoming Commissioner on a "without prejudice" basis, in accordance with the agreement reached at the April 12 meeting in Manila.
