Replying further to your letter of October 27, 1934 and our letter to you of November 16, relative to the setting up of an FERA State Project for the purpose of securing information for an Interstate Federal Adjudication of water rights on Henry's Fork and tributaries, I wish to advise that our local FERA Advisory Committee has approved State Project No. E-F2-133. This project as set up, calls for one Supervising Engineer, two engineers, three assistants, one draftsman and one stenographer.

The project is approved subject to the State of Wyoming setting up and approving a like and similar project, and the water users of Burnt Fork system contributing \$75.32 to cover the State Insurance premium on said project. You are therefore requested to forward to this office, at an early date, the \$75.32 covering the insurance premium which in turn will be deposited in the State Insurance Fund.

Would you kindly advise us if and when Wyoming FERA has set up and approved a like project, that is, a project to gather information for an Interstate Adjudication of the water rights of Henry's Fork and tributaries.
