

Re Burnt Fork.

August 7, 1958

The following is my report for the 1958 irrigation season:

The run-off started May 20 and at that time was when just about all diversions were turned on. It only lasted until June 1st. and at that time I turned Thompson Creek out of Hoop Lake and back into Burnt Fork. That water lasted until June 20th. and at that time Island Lake was released. I had no way to measure the water released or the inflow to the lake. This water lasted until June 27th. and at that time Beaver Meadows was released at 25 cubic feet per second. I diverted 20 feet per second in the Interstate Canal at Burnt Fork. The first adjustments I had to make were July 10 and then no more until July 20th. when I had to turn all ditches off down to 1895 priorities. That is all I have to report.
