Memorandum for Office Study only, by T. H. Humpherys

REL: LONG VALLEY DISTR.

I met the water users of Long Valley at Glendale in the Church house at 10 o'clock Saturday, February 22. There were present about 25 water users, with which was numbered W. S. Carpenter, the Commissioner. I called the meeting to order and acted as chairman since others were not inclined to take the responsibility.

In the beginning the financial statement was discussed and by proper motion accepted and ordered filed. The matter of unpaid or delinquent assessments was next discussed. It was stated and reasonably proved that the following should be deleted from the 1936 assessment roll if and only when the 1935 assessment will have been paid however:

W. S. Carpenter
Roswell DeMill
Muddy Irrigation Company, % D.W.P. Stevens
Alta M. Sorensen
Reuben J. Watson

All of the above except the Muddy Irrigation Company and Carpenter had paid their assessments in advance of this meeting. To make it unanimous, these two assessments were paid and a motion prevailed to delete all of the above.

The matter of headgates and measuring devices was then discussed. The water users were pretty much divided. Motion prevailed, however, that measuring devices should be constructed but there was some difference of opinion as to the number and location of these. It was finally decided, therefore, that in about May the State Engineer would send an engineer to look over these necessities and decide which, if any, should be constructed.

The matter of selection of a Water Commissioner was next considered. Mr. Carpenter and Mr. White were both nominated. Following the vote it was moved that since Mr. White was in the minority that his name be withdrawn and that they unanimously recommend Mr. W. S. Carpenter. The motion prevailed. This was done only, however, after the Commissioner's salary was raised to \$150 a year which Mr. Carpenter agreed to accept for his services.

The State Engineer was authorized to prepare the budget to include, in addition to the Commissioner's salary, such other expenses that would be necessary, pro rate the expense in accordance with the rights and make assessments to cover the expense.
