Dear Mr. Carpenter:

In accordance with a recommendation made by a majority of the water users on the Long Valley Distribution system, I am appointing you Water Commissioner for the season of 1935, beginning May 1, 1935 and ending September 30, 1935, both dates inclusive, under authority of Section 100-5-1, Revised Statutes of Utah, 1933. Your official commission is enclosed herewith.

Please familiarize yourself with the law under which the administration and distribution is to be made, being Sections 100-5-1 to 100-5-10, Revised Statutes of Utah, 1933, inclusive. You should also inform yourself on the rights of all the users, whether such rights be established by use, - "diligence right", decreed rights or rights granted by the State Engineer, so that at all times you will be in full possession of the facts relating rights in your distribution system and thus be able to inform me or any inquiring user with respect to his rights or the rights of any others.

Your records of flow of the main stream and diversions therefrom should be recorded daily and kept in such form as to be readily accessible, also filed so that at the end of the irrigation season you will have full data for use in making a report which will be expected of you. From this time forth, such a report will be expected from each and every water commissioner.
