
Dear Madam:

It appears from the records that you are delinquent on your assessment for distribution purposes on Long Valley for 1934 in the amount of \$1.00.

Under Section 100-5-1, Revised Statutes of Utah, 1933, the State Engineer is required to levy assessments for distribution purposes according to the rights as they appear. This has been done in your case, but you failed to remit the amount due, which makes it incumbent upon the State Engineer, if the user persists in not paying his assessment, to shut off the water until such assessment will have been paid.

Please do not force me to take such action. Kindly remit the amount due.
