East Fork of Virgin River Distribution:

After our conversation this morning, I called Mr. Birt Gardner and discussed the proposed water users meeting with him. It appeared to Mr. Gardner and myself, that the present Water Users organization would be adequate for representation in meetings with the state Engineer. Also, before the Water Users meeting, efforts will be made to secure a water commissioner for recommendation to the State Engineer for approval. My services would be of little help in setting up a budget for the system, since Mr. Gardner felt that the committee will have some good recommendations in mind when the annual meeting is held. The date of the meeting which you suggested for 3:00 p.m., February 10, 1960 at the Mt. Carmel, Utah meeting house is agreeable with the Water Users. Notices of the meeting should be mailed to all Water Users of record as soon as possible.

Coal Creek Distribution:

I discussed your suggestions for the Annual Coal Creek Water Users Meeting with the chairman, Mr. Lorenzo Luke, and Mr. Thelmer Stratton secretary, the time for the meeting has been reset and is now scheduled to be held in the court room in the city and county building in Cedar City, at 7:30 p.m. February 24, 1960.

The suggestion was made to Mr. Stratton that the budget be broken down to show salary, travel expenses, and other items separately, however, a final decision depends on how the Water Commissioner feels about this recommendation. Notices of the meeting may now be sent to all canal representatives for the February 24 meeting.

Thanks for sending a schedule of meetings in this area. I will return the information, which you mailed, when I see you at the Water Users Meeting.
