The records of this office show that you are delinquent on your  
distribution assessments as follows.

Many of the water users have paid their assessments but since you are not numbered among them, payment can not be made to the Water Commissioner as agreed upon at the beginning of the season. Of necessity therefore, it will be imperative to re-assess those who have already paid, or else shut the water off from the delinquents and enter suit to force collections as prescribed by statute.

I am therefore, appealing to you in fairness to all parties concerned, to meet your unpaid assessments promptly and not force me to take either of the two courses above referred to, both of which are embarrassing and expensive to all parties concerned.

Dear Sir:

Under authority conferred by Section 62, Chapter 67, Laws of Utah, 1919, as amended, the distribution of water from.....will be under the supervision of the State Engineer, acting through Mr..... as water commissioner. Said Section provides that:

"The salary and expenses of such commissioner or deputy commissioner or commissioners shall be borne pro rata by the users of water from such river system or water source, upon a schedule to be fixed by the State Engineer, based on the established rights of each water user, and such pro rata share shall be paid by each water user to the State Engineer in advance on or before the 1st day of May of each year, and upon failure so to do, the State Engineer may forbid the use of water by any such delinquent while such default continues, or may bring an action in the court for such unpaid expense and salary, and such court may issue an order to show cause upon any delinquent user or users why a judgment for said sum should not be entered."

Your pro rata share under the above provision for the coming irrigation season as scheduled is \$..... This sum must be deposited with the State Engineer on or before.....in order that funds may be available for meeting the cost of distribution for the coming season. You will note particularly that the above quoted section gives the State Engineer power to forbid the use of water to anyone who is delinquent while said default continues.
