Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of August 11 in which you ask first, what is the proper step for you to take to have the use of your water and, second, will I kindly see that J.L. Bowers places a control gate and weir on the head of his ditch.

Referring to the first question, you are advised to confer with the Water Commissioner W.S. Carpenter whose duty it is to see that water, if available, be delivered to you in accordance with your rights; to the second, you are advised that my assistant, Mr. Reid Jerman, has made an inspection of the Bowers gate and weir. From his report it appears to me that the present structure is entirely adequate to meet the situation unless it be that it be interfered with after same has been adjusted by the commissioner.

Interference as referred to, has been made and is annoying. I have had steps taken and hope to be able to remedy this condition by having a permanent restraining order issued by the court against both you and Mr. Bowers. When this will have been accomplished, I am sure the trouble will cease.
