Sept. 7, 1933:

Delinquent notices sent to water users.  
\$10.00 paid to Water Commissioner with notation that delinquents  
be contacted and payment urged.

Oct. 7, 1933:

\$6.00 paid Water Commissioner.

Oct. 10, 1933:

Reply to letter of Oct. 5 of Birt Gardner (representing Adjudicating  
Committee) - "Let me urge that you contact the delinquents as soon  
as possible and press with persistence final payments to the end  
that sufficient money will have been collected to pay the Water  
Commissioner."

Personal letters written to certain of delinquents as suggested by  
Birt Gardner.

Oct. 11, 1933:

Claim voucher of Oct. 7 for \$6.00 returned with notation that in  
addition to the \$40.00 balance yet due according to our figures, he  
had made 2 trips on Sept. 2 and 4, respectively, at a cost of \$3.50  
each, leaving therefore a balance due of \$47.00, from which was to  
be deducted for his 1931 assessment \$1.40, leaving a total balance  
due of \$45.60.

Oct. 18, 1933:

Assessment roll sent to Water Commissioner with notation: "It appears  
that there is yet due \$109.55. I hope you will be able to collect  
a considerable amount of this sum, at least enough to pay the  
expenses involved for water distribution during the season of 1933."

Jan. 6, 1934:

Attached letter received. It is not clear to me how Mr. Carpenter  
figures there is \$47.50 due, since on Oct. 11, according to his  
statement there was due \$45.60.

Balance on hand as of this date \$12.36.
