I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 28 enclosing check for \$12.50 in payment of your Company's distribution assessment in Long Valley.

According to previous understanding had with you I served the Orderville Irrigation Company and the Glendale Irrigation Company, on July 3, 1931, with notice requiring the installation of dividers. I am advised that this was not done within the thirty day period allowed and I am, therefore, authorized by law to do the work myself.
