RE: LONG VALLEY DIST.

I have your letter of September 24 reporting on your work in Long Valley for this season and regret to note the failure of the two canal companies to put in dividers as ordered. It may be well to bring this matter up again before next season in case the Mt. Carmel people come to realize its importance.

I also note your statement of time and consider the same reasonable in view of the conditions this year. I am enclosing check for \$70 on account and voucher for the total amount of \$76. I would ask you to sign this voucher, have it sworn to before a notary and return to the office.

According to the books of the office the Mt. Carmel Irrigation Company has not paid its assessment for this year, amounting to \$12.50, and I suggest that you advise them that unless this amount is paid promptly I shall find it necessary to take legal proceedings for collection.
