Long Valley Distribution

On Saturday, June 27, the State Engineer met with Commissioner Birt Gardner, Osmer Lamb, D. W. P. Stevens, to discuss conditions of Long Valley distribution.

The only difficulties of moment related to the diversions by the Orderville Irrigation Company and the Glendale Irrigation Company. It appeared that neither of these Companies had an adequate headgates or measuring devices and after further consideration it was agreed that the best solution was to have both Companies install dividers at the head of their canal, these dividers permitting, in cases of flash floods, the two Companies to take their share of water and yet allow that portion of the floods, to which the lower users were entitled, to go back into the channel. The State Engineer agreed to give the necessary orders to these two Companies, the Mt. Carmel Irrigation Company agreeing to furnish the necessary funds, if the State Engineer had to do the work, with the understanding that the State Engineer thereafter would proceed legally to collect the money and refund it to the Mt. Carmel Irrigation Company. The dividers were to be put in under the supervision of Commissioner Gardner.
