

Orderville, Utah
June 13, 1930

The meeting of the share holders of the East Fork of the Virgin River, called for June 12 at Orderville, was convened at 11 a. m. with practically all of the primary stock represented.

C. A. Heaton, President of the Orderville Irrigation Co., was elected chairman of the meeting and I. H. Esplin of the Orderville Irrigation Co. as secretary.

An agreement was reached with F. A. Porter to act as water commissioner at \$5.50 per day. An estimate of not more than \$75 for the 1930 season. Because of the urgent need of a division of the water, it was unanimously decided to ask the State Engineer to ~~make~~ the appointment at once.

On motion of Ruben J. Watson, President of the Glendale Irrigation Co., seconded by Valentine C. Tait of the Mt. Carmel board, it was decided to ask the State Engineer for the 1931 season to call a meeting by publication in a newspaper; said meeting to be held at Orderville, Feb. 23, 1931 at 8 p.m.
