

Dear Mr. Lambert:

Since the Water Users Meeting held in the Iron County Court House I have been advised by President Bayles that you desire applicants for Water Commissioner to make application to your office, with a copy to the Chairman of the water Users Meeting to be held Feb. 13, for their consideration and recommendations.

I have given considerable thought to the requirements as outlined by the representatives of the State Engineer's Office, and believe that I could preform the duties and responsibilities as out lined by them, as Water Commissioner of the Parowan Valley Basin.

I have either worked at, or owned Day Farm for about 30 years, which has given me some knowledge and background of water development in this basin. Serving as President, and also as Secretary Treasurer of the Parowan Valley Pumpers Association, has also given me a broader look at matters concerning water and power use in the Parowan Valley Basin.

I will be able to preform the physical functions of the Commissioner more easily, by having, and being able to use with some proficiency the typewriter, and 10 key adding machine. I perhaps have some background in the service that would be of merit. I served as a Radar and Radio Operator, doing charting, aircraft plotting, map reading, station keeping at sea, coded message break-down, and other related duties.

I understand that some mechanical aptitude could be desireable, for the repairing of meters. Not as the duty as Commissioner, but as a convience to the water meter users. I believe that I could learn to handle repairs quite easily. As I have been able to do all of the repairs at our Farm with the exception of those of a specialized nature, or requireing special equipment.

I am presently rearranging the duties at my farm, so that I will be able to preform the duties of another part time position that I have accepted, and would like to have the Water Commissioners Job to fill in some of my spare time.
