

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE DUCHESNE STRAWBERRY WATER
USERS WITH THE STATE ENGINEER STAFF

Date; March 7, 1973 - Held in the Duchesne County Courthouse courtroom at 11:00 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Don Norseth of the State Engineer's Office. He stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss distribution problems and any special items of business that may come before the group. He gave a water forecast as of February 1, 1973, and stated that the expected flow was 120 per cent of normal. However this is 21 per cent less than 1972. As of March 1, 1973 the expectation had dropped down to 109 per cent of the average normal flow. With this introduction this meeting was turned over to Mr. Ray Thomas, president of the Duchesne-Strawberry Water Users, to conduct the meeting as he saw fit.

The minutes for last year were called for and read. A question on one of the items was the pen-vane and its repayment. It was announced by the State Engineer's Staff that the pen-vane assessment will be collected in the 1973 collections. There was a motion made by Frank Liddell, seconded by Melvin White that the minutes be accepted as read.

Mr. Thomas asked for the financial report, and it was given as such.
