

COAL CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

** 1960 ASSESSMENT **

\$1,350.00

FORWARD:

A majority of the water users' of Coal Creek requested the State Engineer to distribute their water under the authority of his office commencing with the 1960 season. (See Minutes of Water Users' Meeting dated February 24, 1960, filed in the Permanent File of the Coal Creek Distribution System in the Accounting Department.)

The State Engineer, having no official distribution records, will use the Coal Creek Water Users' Annual Report of Water Delivered to each listed user. Such report will be used until proper State Engineer Distribution Records can be obtained. These reports were compiled by Mr. Theron Ashcroft and Mr. Clemont Adams.

BASIS OF ASSESSMENT:

The 1960 Assessment is based upon a 5-year average delivery of acre-feet of water covering the years of 1955-1959, inclusive. (Water Users' report - T. Ashcroft and C. Adams.)

CALCULATION OF ASSESSMENT:

The State Engineer has been advised that there is one water user-California-Pacific Utilities Company-who has agreed to pay 30 per cent of the yearly assessment, but in no case is such payment to exceed \$360.00

Taking into consideration the flat assessment of \$360.00 (30% of \$1,350.00 equals \$405.00) which is deducted from the total 1960 assessment of \$1,350.00, this leaves a balance of \$990.00 which is to be assessed to all other listed Coal Creek Water Users'.

Therefore, \$990.00 divided by 18,339.60 5 year average acre/feet of water equals \$0.0539815482 cost for one 5 year average acre/foot of water which each listed water user is to be assessed in preparing his/her pro-rata share of the total assessment.
