RE: Alvey Wash Distribution System

Dear Judge Tibbs:

I have had the opportunity to visit briefly with Mr. Melvin Alvey of Escalante, Utah, concerning the water commissioner position on Alvey Wash. He expressed his regrets for having missed the annual meeting in Escalante and admitted an oversight on his part. I informed him on the proceedings of the meeting, explaining to him some of the problems that we felt were in the system, and asked him if he would be interested in taking the job for another year. His answer was affirmative and I will make arrangements in the very near future to meet with him and review the system, taking into consideration some of the questions that were brought up and the problems we have experienced.

Based on this contact I assume that the appointment could be made if you are in agreement with this selection. If I haven't heard back from you in the next week I will assume that we agree, from past conversations, that Mr. Alvey is our man.

It is possible that after we have met in the field to review the system that we may have some strong recommendations to be made in connection with the measurement and distribution of the water. I'll keep Mr. Norseth aware of this information so that in any event you may call one of us for any questions you may have.
