RE: Alvey Wash Distribution System

We have received in this office a report from Mr. Melvin Alvey, Commissioner, concerning the record of distribution of water on Alvey Wash near Escalante, Utah. It is noted that the supply of water was fairly constant during the irrigation season and the commissioner explained that during the month of June there was more than enough water to satisfy all of the rights and he did not record the flows during that month. To complete the report we have computed the water delivered in June based on a factor of 1.1 (110%) of the July delivery record.

The record below is compiled from the report submitted by Mr. Alvey and assuming that Judge Tibbs will endorse the system for another season we will use this information for making the assessments. It is to be noted that Truman Spencer's water meter became disabled during August, 1973, and the yearly total has been estimated based on previous use.
