In response to your letter of May 14 concerning the order to Leo Wilson to install parshall flumes in his diversions in the Alvey Wash System, we issued blanket orders to every water user in need of diversion and/or measuring devices on Alvey Wash. This is not an order peculiar to your client.

We would suggest that Mr. Wilson contact Gerald Stoker or the Soil Conservation Service in his area for advice on just where to put the parshall flumes or some other proper measuring devices if he prefers. The installation of the parshall flumes, to our thinking, is the method that would be most economical and least difficult to install.
