Thank you for yours of May 10th, advising me of the requirement that is being made that Mr. Leo Wilson install parshall flumes in the Alvey Wash System. I assume, though I have not been advised by your office, that a similar requirement is being made of all others who are making use of water from the Alvey Wash.

I have some reservation as to exactly how a parshall flume can properly be installed in the diversions on this Alvey Wash. I would appreciate your observations on this or the observations of Mr. Stoker at your early convenience, and also advice as to whether this is a general order for all users on the Wash or if there is some peculiarity which has resulted in your making this order only pertinent to Leo Wilson.
