RE: Alvey Wash Distribution

Dear Mr. Spencer:

You are, hereby, advised that before you can divert any water from Alvey Wash that it will be necessary to file with our office a permanent change application on the point of diversion and method of diversion. If you still propose to pump from a sump in or adjacent to the river then your pipeline should be equipped with a totalizing meter measuring both in cubic feet per second and acre feet.

As you plan on the amount that can be pumped from the sump it should be remembered that you can only divert up to your proportional share of the 3.47 CFS that has been certificated to you and Leo Wilson. In other words, between you and Leo it will be possible to divert from the river a total of 3.47 CFS. In addition to this you will be limited on the acre feet withdrawal during an irrigation season as described in the Proposed Determination of Water Rights.
