James G. Olsen made a motion that we accept the Financial ^{Report}, second by Don Prestwich, motion carried.

Water Commissioner Blaine Draper gave us the annual report on the snow and the water out look for 1970, he said that the moisture was far better then last year for this time of the year.

John Bene asked Blaine Draper if he had any trouble with dividing the water? Blaine said yes on the Graveyard ditch and other ditches up above.

Stanley Price asked about the Bagnal Ditch Divider? there was a lot talk about this divider,

James G. Olsen told them that he was the one appointed to get these gates put in, and they meet at the dam and agree just how they should be put in, and he had them put just that way. James G. Olsen told them that these gates would not divider the as it should be divided. but they said put them in that way and he did.

Reed Cheney made a motion that we assess \$2500.00 on our 1970 budget, second by Rodney J. Peterson, motion carried.

There was a lot told about who should be the Water Commissioner, and was agreed that we leave it up to the State Engineer. to decide.

John Bene asked if there was any question that they wont answered, no one asked any.

John Jensen asked if there was any way to divide the water difference from the Cox Decree. John Bene said no.

Kenward H. McKinney told us that there was some filling been made on water, but there is no permit made at present time.

Stanley Price asked if there was any chance of putting the two Sanpitch districts into one ?

John Jensen said that it to big a job for one man to handle the whole river. There was a lot of objection to put the whole river to-gather.

There was a lot tald about the dividers along the Sanpitch river.

It was agreed if any director can not be present to meeting ,that he can appoint some one to reperesent him, but it must be made in writing.
