

## Virgin River Assessment

The assessment is levied on the second-feet of water right. The rights are broken down according to priority into primary and secondary rights. The primary rights are assessed at a rate three times that of the secondary rights. The assessment is calculated by multiplying the primary rights by three, adding the secondary rights, and dividing into the total budget to obtain a general factor. The individual assessment for primary rights is three times the second-feet of water times the general factor. The secondary rights are assessed by multiplying the second-feet of water rights times the general factor.

### Term of Commissioner

The commissioner's term of duty shall begin April First and extend for one year or until a successor is appointed.


### Disbursement of Funds

Funds shall be expended by the State Engineer as set out in the budget by submission of voucher by the water commissioner. Retirement, income taxes, social security taxes, and all other taxes and insurance shall be dispensed as set by statute.

- A. Overexpenditure of any budget item shall be by submission of a voucher which has been signed by the chairman and approved by the distribution engineer of the Division of Water Rights.
- B. Special budget items will be paid on submission of a voucher signed by the chairman and approved by the distribution engineer of the Division of Water Rights.

### Reports

The commissioner will submit four copies of his annual report to the Division of Water Rights by March First of each year. Other reports will be submitted as specified by the water users on a current basis.
