The president called for the secretarys report, which was given and accepted on a motion by Reed Wittwer, seconded by Claud Braswell.

The fininical report was given by Mr. Hall and accepted on a motion by Rudgar McArthur, seconded by Reed Wittwer.

Mr. Hall gave a brief report on what is being done by the State in regards to surplus monies held in trust by the State.

Motion by Rudgar McArthur that the State Engineer be authorized to invest irrigation monies in an interest bearing account for our benifit. Seconded by Floyd Ence. Motion carried.

The budget recommendation was called for. Floyd Ence made the motion that the budget remain the same as last year except that line item 5 be moved to and included in line item 3 and that an assessment be made to cover the budget. Seconded by Reed Wittwer. Motion carried.

The president called for recommendation for commissioner. Floyd Ence made the motion that Rodney Leavitt be recommended. Seconded by Clint Hardman. Motion carried.

The President called for election of officers. Floyd Ence made the motion that the reles be suspended and the existing board be voted in by acclimation. Seconded by Rudgar McArthur. Carried.

Mr. Hall noted that Mr. Robert L. Morgan has been appointed as the State Engineer.
