To All Water Users of the Lower Jordan River:

Enclosed is your assessment notice for your pro rata share of distribution cost for the Lower Jordan River for 1966.

In accordance with the agreement secured during a meeting of a selected portion of the water users of the Jordan River, held July 21, 1966 in the State Capitol, the State Engineer appoints Glen Allen as water commissioner. Mr. Allen is not a registered engineer. He has four years of college training, was an employee of this office and was employed by the U. S. Geological Survey. It is felt that his background qualifies him and that he will be able to do a good job. He has been assigned the duty of distributing the waters of the Jordan River from the 21st South Surplus Canal heading to the Great Salt Lake. Instructions to him indicate that the 1966 distribution will be without prejudice or precedent toward final adjudication of rights and that the proposed schedule will be in effect for this year only. The breakdown and water allocation between the users will be as follows:

1. Only diligence rights shall be considered and they shall be considered as being of equal priority.
2. The flow of Lower Jordan River at the head of the Surplus Canal shall be divided 50% into the Surplus Canal, and 50% into the Lower Jordan River. It is noted that although quality is a problem, that both branches agreed they would have to get by on their 50% allocated quantity.
3. That the water regulation shall be limited to rights diverting more than one second-foot of water or irrigating more than 50 acres of land, the assessment also is to be limited to these categories.
4. The water in the Surplus Canal and in the Lower Jordan River to be allocated on this basis if a full supply is available; if a full supply is not available, a percentage basis will be used in distribution.

*Note:*

Mr. Allen will start his duties Monday, August 8, 1966, and will be contacting all major users within a short time. Your cooperation in seeing that Mr. Allen receives keys to all locked gates will be appreciated. Each user is responsible for the installation of any needed measuring devices or control works.
