

MINUTES OF THE
GEORGE CREEK WATER USERS MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the George Creek Water User's and the Division of Water Rights was held on March 15, 1983, at the home of Stanley Spencer. The meeting was called to order by Michael Turnipseed of the Division of Water Rights at 1:15 p.m.

The minutes of the 1982 meeting were read by Bob Fotheringham. Corrections and additons were called for. One correction was made. The name on the second page second paragraph should read Darwin Thompson instead of Norman Thompson. Motion to approve the minutes as read with one correction was made by Stanley Spencer, seconded by Yale Montgomery. Motion passed.

Commissioner Mike Spencer read the commissioners report and stated that Karl Oman's measuring device will not measure in low flow. It has not been a problem because he only takes water in that ditch during high water, but should be corrected if low water is to be taken.

There was a discussion on whether to continue the system. There have been no problems for the past several years. They voted to continue the system as is, with the State Engineers supervision.
