

GEORGE CREEK WATER USER'S MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the George Creek Water User's and the Division of Water Rights was held on March 10, 1976, at the Yost Ward Church house.

Chairman Wallace Spencer called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

R. Michael Turnipseed, Area Engineer, read the financial report for 1975. At the end of the 1975 water year, the George Creek Water User's had a balance of \$18.37 in the State Engineer Fund. Motion was called for on the budget. Darwin Thompson moved that the report be accepted as read and Yale Montgomery seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Water Commissioner, Michael Spencer, mentioned that he had to pay all of the Social Security Withholdings the past year and wanted Dee Hansen to check into this matter. Dee agreed to check on the matter.

Chairman Spencer next called for the Commissioner's Report. Michael Spencer stated that it was a very good year. On June 15, 130 c.f.s. was in the Creek. The flow sustained itself over the season very well. There was approximately three times more water in 1975 than in 1974. Some work needs to be accomplished on Collin Booth and Carl Oman's diversions to secure them better and make more accurate measuring possible. Chairman Spencer requested that the Water Commissioner talk with these two users and ask them to repair their diversions.

The budget for the 1976 water year was the next item of business. It was decided that the Commissioner's Salary would remain at \$1400.00, matching Social Security is \$81.90 and the bonds and insurance would be \$25.00, bringing the total expenditures to \$1506.90. It was the consencous of opinion that the assessment would be set at \$1500.00. A motion was made by Mike Spencer and seconded by Darwin Thompson to accept the budget as prepared. The motion passed.

Darwin Thompson proposed the name of Michael Spencer for Water Commissioner. for the coming water year. Yale Montgomery seconded the proposal. Those present supported the nomination.

There seemed to be no problems with winter water this year, mainly because there was plenty of water. The east channel was repaired by some of the water users this past year. Joe Taylor took his own water this past year, but Chairman Spencer asked Mr. Taylor to please cooperate with the Water Commissioner in taking his water.

It was proposed by Mike Spencer that the officers of the George Creek Water User's remain the same for the coming year. The proposal was seconded by Thomas Teeter. Those present supported the motion. They are as follows:
