

GEORGE CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM


*** 1976 WATER ASSESSMENT ***
\$ 1,500.00

FORWARD: As per the verbal conversation with Mike Turnipseed of Logan Office, on June 1, 1976, the Salt Lake Office was informed the 1976 Assessment is to be the amount of \$ 1,500.00. Also, he felt that the same amount of acre-feet of water could be used to calculate the total assessment for 1976 that had been used for previous years. Therefore, the amount of \$ 1,500.00 divided by 2,374.00 acre-feet of water equals \$ 0.63184499, cost of one pro-rata acre-foot of water, which times that amount of water delivered by each listed user on the Distribution System equals his or her 1976 Water Assessment.

PROOF:

\$ 0.63184499 times 2,374.00 equals \$ 1,500.00
