

GEORGE CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

\*\*\* 1969 ASSESSMENT \*\*\*

\$ 1,425.00

BASIS OF ASSESSMENT:

This Distribution System is now assessed according to the Commissioner's report of water used in the previous year by each individual water user. Note: High water rights will be assessed only if the high water is delivered to proper rights. The peak flow of George Creek did not rise above 66.00 CFS, therefore, high-water rights are not to be assessed.

CALCULATION OF ASSESSMENT:


The 1969 minutes stipulate that the 1969 assessment is to be \$ 1,425.00 with the Commissioner's Official report showing that 2,374.00 acre-feet of water had been delivered to the listed water users in 1968.

Therefore, \$ 1,425.00 divided by 2,374.00 acre-feet of water equals \$ 0.600252738, cost of one pro-rata acre-foot of water times that amount of water divereted by each listed user on the system equals their pro-rata share of the 1969 Assessment.
