

GEORGE CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

*** 1968 ASSESSMENT ***

\$ 1,220.00 (see below)

BASIS OF ASSESSMENT:

This Distribution System is now assessed according to the Commissioner's report of water used in the previous year by each individual water user. Note: High water rights will be assessed only if the high water is delivered to proper rights. The peak flow of George Creek did rise above 66.00 CFS, therefore, high-water rights will be assessed.

CALCULATION OF ASSESSMENT:

The 1968 Budget amounts to \$ 1,225.00 and the 1968 Assessment is to be \$ 1,220.00, as decided at the 1968 Annual Water Users meeting. (See minutes of that meeting.)

The Commissioner's 1967 Annual Report states that 5,795.00 acre-feet of water was diverted during 1967. Therefore, \$ 1,220.00 divided by 5,795.00 acre-feet equals \$ 0.210526316, cost of one pro-rata acre-foot of water. This cost multiplied times the reported amount of water diverted by each user on the system equals their pro-rata share of the 1968 Assessment.


