

GEORGE CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

\*\*\* 1967 ASSESSMENT \*\*\*  
\$ 825.00

BASIS OF ASSESSMENT:

This Distribution System is now assessed according to the Commissioner's report of water used in the previous year by each individual water user. NOTE: High water interest will be assessed only if the high water is delivered to their proper rights. The peak flow of George Creek did not rise above 66.00 CFS during 1966, therefore, the high-water rights will not be assessed.

CALCULATION OF ASSESSMENT:

The 1967 Budget amounts to \$ 825.00 and the 1967 Assessment is also to be \$ 825.00, as decided at the 1967 Annual Water Users Meeting with the representatives of the State Engineer.

The 1966 Commissioner's Annual Report states that 2,950.56 acre-feet of water was diverted during 1966. Therefore, \$ 825.00 divided by 2,950.56 acre-feet equals \$ 0.2796079389, cost of one pro-rata acre-foot of water. This cost multiplied times the reported amount of water diverted by each water user on George Creek Distribution System equals their pro-rated share of the 1967 Assessment.
