

LITTLE BEAR RIVER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

\*\* 1968 ASSESSMENT \*\*

\$ 1,100.00

FORWARD:

The 1968 Water Assessment is to be again based on the Commissioner's Annual Report of water delivered during the year of 1967. The Commissioner reports that 48,032.00 acre-feet of water was delivered during 1967.

CALCULATION OF 1968 ASSESSMENT:

The first step is to determine the minimum \$ 5.00 users and the maximum (or less) of acre-feet delivery for such users.

\$ 1,100.00 divided by 48,032.00 acre-feet of water equals \$0.0229013990 and \$ 5.00 divided by \$ 0.0229013990 equals 218.00 acre-feet of water (or less) to be the minimum amount assessed for such users, of \$ 5.00.

There are 22 such users whose total delivery of water is 1,684.00 acre-feet which subtracted from 48,032.00 leaves 46,348.00 acre-feet of water to be assessed against the remainder of users.

\$ 1,100.00	equals	48,032.00 Ac/ft	(all users)
less <u>110.00</u>	equals	<u>1,684.00 Ac/ft</u>	(min \$5.00 users)

therefore: \$ 990.00 equals 46,348.00 Ac/ft

\$ 990.00 divided by 46,348.00 Acre-feet equals \$ 0.0213601450, cost of one pro-rated acre-foot of water multiplied times the amount listed for each user is his/her 1968 Water Assessment.
