Little Bear Assessment Review 1969 ^{1/}

Paradise Irrigation Company's 1966 assessment shows a raise of 66% over 1965 assessment. Other assessments show a drop of approximately 14%. To correct the assessment because of inaccurate diversion records it is suggested that the 1965, 1967 and 1968 assessment be averaged. This average assessment is then to be levied against Paradise Irrigation Company for 1966.
