BASIS OF ASSESSMENT:

The 1962 Assessment is based upon a 5-year average delivery of acre-feet of water for the years of 1957- 1961, inclusive, with a minimum assessment of \$ 2.00 for any one water user who may be assessed, in accordance with the commissioner's Annual Report of Water delivered and as listed in the Office of the State Engineer.

ACRE-FEET OF WATER DELIVERED:

Total Delivery, 1961	31,539.66
Total Delivery (1957-1961)	204,444.46
Total Average Delivery (57-61)	40,888.89

CALCULATION OF THE 1962 ASSESSMENT:

The first problem is to determine the minimum \$ 2.00 users and the maximum amount or less, acre-foot delivery for such users. It is determined that 104.25 acre-foot or less is such an amount and there are 20 such users totaling 1,289.08 acre-feet which is subtracted from the total 1962 5-year average and assessment.

	\$ 800.00 equals 40,888.89 acre feet for all users
Less	(40.00) equals 1,289.08 acre feet for minimum \$ 2.00 users
then	760.00 equals 39,599.81 acre feet for Regular Users

\$ 760.00 divided by 39,599.81 acre-feet equals \$ 0.0191920113 cost for one five-year average acre-foot of water times the amount listed for each such Regular User.
