J. H. Wright made motion that we recommend Erwin Moser to be our commissioner for 1958. Second by Evan H. Bankhead. Motion was carried.

Next order of business was to consider the budget for 1958 which

Minutes of meeting held February, 20, 1958

The annual meeting of the Little Bear River Water Users Association was held February 20, 1958 at the City Hall, Hyrum, Utah at 11:00 a.m.

The call of the meeting was read by the State Engineer.

Mr. Criddle made the report that there was no major changes in his office and that he desired to work in harmony with our board and commissioner. He also explained how our money is spent in his office. He stated that Mr. Howells should preside at the meeting until another is appointed.

Secretary Seth P. Leishman read the minutes of the last meeting. Fred Summers made a motion that the minutes be accepted. Marion Olsen seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The financial report was read and explained by Frank Reese. His report showed that all accounts were paid to date. Marion Olsen moved that we accept the report as read. Grant Hall seconded the motion. Motion carried. Mr. Reese made the suggestion that his office have authority to assess and collect the 1958 budget with a minimum assessment of \$2.00 per person. Marion Olsen put this suggestion in the form of a motion. Samuel McMurdie seconded the motion. It carried.

Mr. Howells felt we should keep our present commissioner, Erwin Moser. He requested a \$200.00 raise in his salary. The board seemed satisfied with Mr. Moser's service and recommended that he be re-appointed.

Fred Summers made motion that Engineer Erwin Moser be recommended to State Engineer's office to be appointed as our Engineer for 1958. Carl Danielson seconded that motion. Motion carried.


The budget for 1958 was next considered. After some discussion, the following budget was approved:
