Dear Mr. Teichert:

Since the Wyoming people are not satisfied with our joint water commissioner of last year, and since the major portion of the water goes to Wyoming interests on Burnt Fork, it is suggested that you select the commissioner for 1964 with Utah contributing up to \$270.00 as contained in our operating budget. We would require and I am sure that Wyoming would concur, in distribution according to rights and a complete report on the distribution in Utah at the end of the season.

So far as Henry's Fork is concerned, we do not yet have an agreed interstate schedule and would not wish to attempt distribution on this stream until such a schedule has been completed.
