

MILFORD DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

1960 ASSESSMENT

FORWARD:

The Escalante Valley Distribution System consisting of the Milford Area and the Beryl-Enterprise Area under the supervision of the State Engineer, by court order of the 5th District Court, during the years of 1958-1959 separated for 1960 and each area becomes a distinct system.

BASIS OF 1960 ASSESSMENT

The assessment is based upon a two-year average delivery of pumped or surface water for the years of 1958 and 1959.

The commissioner's report shows the following acre-feet of water (both surface and underground) chargeable on a pro-rata basis to each listed water user:

1958 a/ft. equals	\$37,381.00
1959 a/ft. equals	40,804.00
Two year Total equals	78,185.00
Two year average equals	39,092.50

CALCULATION OF ASSESSMENT

\$1,710.00 divided by 39,092.50 a/ft. equals \$0.0437424059 cost of one pro-rata acre-foot of water for which each user must then pay multiplied by the number of his/ her 2-year average use.
